Located at 458 Commerce the "Williams Building" was built circa 1909 by W. C. Williams whose family initially used the upstairs as living quarters. Over the years, the building has been used primarily as a hardware store. During that time, the hardware business was owned by various individuals including Mr. Traylor, Mr. Price, Mr. Barnett, Mr. Gist, and Henry Lawson.

During the 1930s and early '40s the building housed a grocery store run by Harley

Lewis.

The renovated structure now houses the Palacios Area Fund and several doctors' offices on the first floor. The second floor is now occupied by the Jobs Training Program offices. In addition, the City State Bank of Palacios has meeting and conference rooms on the ground floor.
